



Parent Code of Conduct

Introduction

This code has been developed for parents and those with parental responsibilities ensuring they are aware of and meet the Preschool's expectations with regard to their interactions with the preschool, its educators, other parents and children.

Purpose

Adherence to this Code is important to promote positive and productive relationships within the preschool community.

Policy

The preschool is responsible for fostering positive relationships amongst children, staff, families and our community. It is important that parents recognise and respect this and adhere to these requirements.

Procedures

Preschool educators make time to discuss children's development throughout the day, at pick up and drop off times. If a parent wishes to meet with an educator for an extended time they can request a more suitable time. Parents should never contact an educator outside of preschool or on social media.

Parents can also request a meeting with the Preschool Director if they have any particular concerns.

It is important that parents show respect for all staff, preschool families and visitors and not publicly criticise them or undermine them in any way.

The Preschool has a duty of care to protect all staff and for this reason any intimidating, aggressive or abusive behaviour will not be tolerated.

Communications whether verbal or in writing should:

- Show respect, courtesy and consideration;
- Not harass or bully others
- Not use intemperate language
- Not be confrontational
- Social media should not be used to criticise or denigrate others.

If a parent fails to observe this Code of Conduct after being warned about a breach the preschool may terminate the enrolment of the child.
